- Equine Therapy




Family Involvement

A cornerstone of ARCH Academy is parent involvement. Parents will join us for a 3-day intensive on-site program. Families are also encouraged to participate in weekly sessions and spiritual services. Prior to discharge, there are opportunities for off campus and home visits with family to practice newly acquired skills.

Education

ARCH Academy operates a fully accredited private high school with grades 8-12 and includes credit recovery options and follow up academic placement. Statistics show most teens in the ARCH Academy core curriculum advance an entire grade level while in treatment. We also work in collaboration with Collegiate Recovery Programs for our seniors.



Resident Profile

Our residents have a primary substance abuse diagnosis and it's not uncommon for them to have a co-occurring diagnosis such as depression, anxiety, ADHD, trauma or grief. ARCH Academy programming is designed to meet the needs of all patients.





Alumni

ARCH Academy views our alumni as the core foundation of our mission. We pride ourselves on staying connected with alumni, inviting them back to campus regularly for on-site events.



The program is an average of six months long and divided into three phases.

Phase 1: Primary care and assessment

Phase 2: Identify issues in greater depth such as anxiety, depression and family dynamics

Phase 3: Focus on transition and living skills
